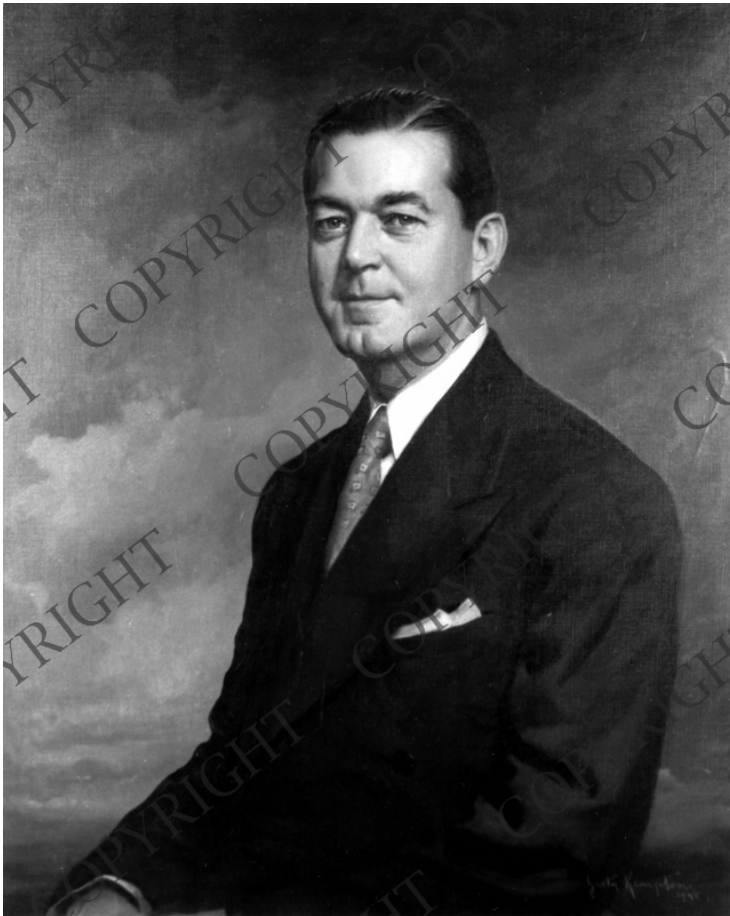


Portrait of Robert Hannegan
