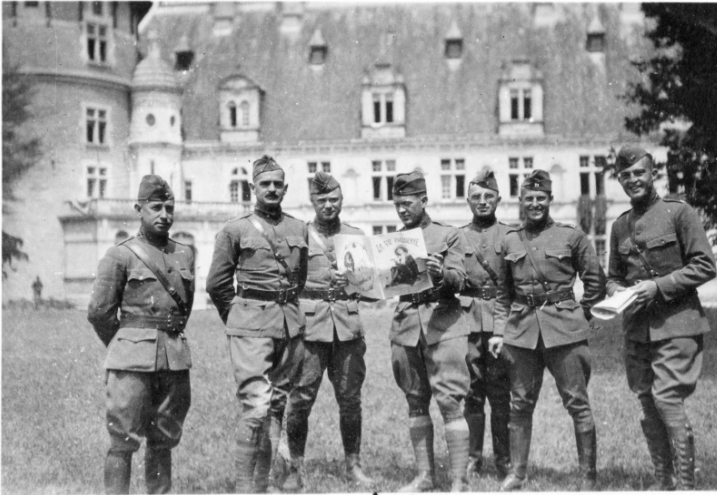


# Truman with soldiers in France, World War I
