Recording Presence. - Persons entering or leaving properties during periods when such properties are closed to the public shall sign the register and/or display authorized identification documents when re-

Preservation of Property. - It is unlawful to wilfully destroy, damage, or remove property or any part thereof, including signs, regulations, decorations, or other facility or equipment, or any tree or other plant

Conformity with Signs and Emergency Directions. - Persons in and on property shall comply with "No Smoking" and other official signs of a prohibitory or directory nature, and at the time of a fire alarm or othe Emergence imple head to complete the direct descent

In or on property is proIntoxicating Beverages and Narcotics. - Entering property or the operating of a motor whicle thereon, by a person under the influence of intox esting beverages or narcotic drug, or the consumption of such beverage of the use of such drug in or on property, is prohibited.

Soliciting and Vending. - The soliciting of alms and contributions, commercial soliciting and vending of all kinds, the display or distribution of commercial advertising, or the collecting of private detts, in or n property, is prohibited. This rule does not apply to national ce local drives for finds for vendiner, health, and does not apply to national ce local drives

Autography for News, Advertising, or Commercial Purposes, - Permision will be granted by the General Services Administ retaino. Building Supritandent or Custodian in charge, for taking photographis for news, adurising, or commercial purposes within the property, provided the Conent of the occupant agency or agencies has been oklaned.

 <u>Dogs and Other Animals</u>, - Dogs and other animals, except seeing eye dogs, shall not be brought upon property for other than official purposes
