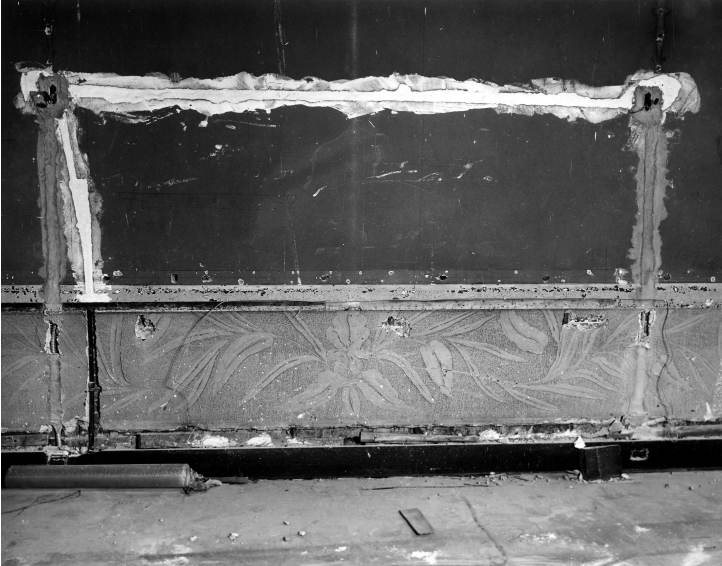


White House Red Room Wall
