Former President Harry S. Truman is shown at a Kansas City Athletics baseball game. Mr. Truman turns to speak to Missouri Governor James Blair (wearing a hat) and Kansas Governor George Docking in the row behind him. Governor Blair threw the first pitch to Governor Docking at this game, which was the season opener. Tom Evans (seated to Mr. Truman's left) and Bess Truman (on Mr. Evans' left), and Lester Milgram (in glasses and hat) also attended the game at Municipal Stadium in Kansas City, Missouri.
