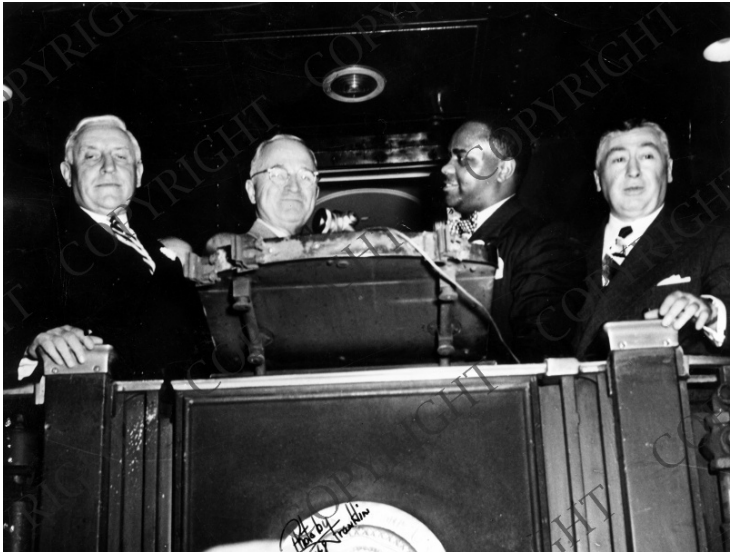


# President Harry S. Truman and Roscoe L. McCrary
