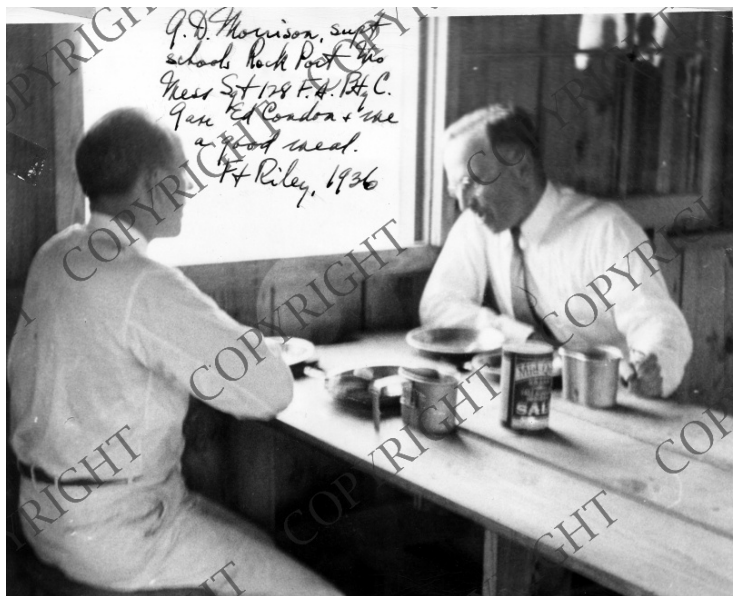


# Senator Truman and Ed Condon eating
