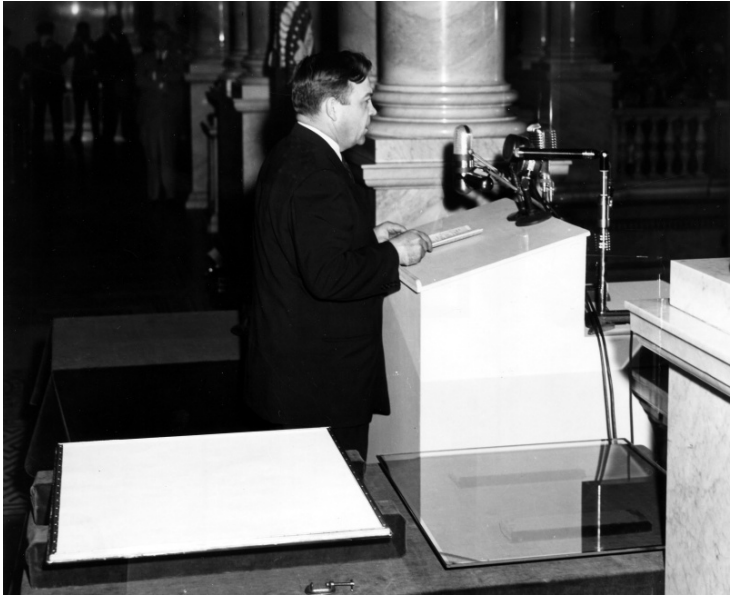


Unidentified speaker at Constitution Day ceremonies at the Library of Congress
