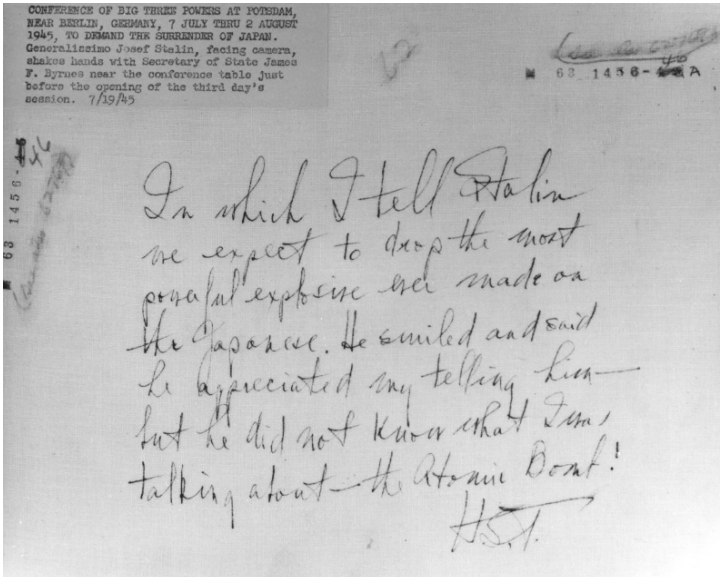


# Truman's handwriting on the back of a Potsdam photograph describing telling Stalin about the atomic bomb
