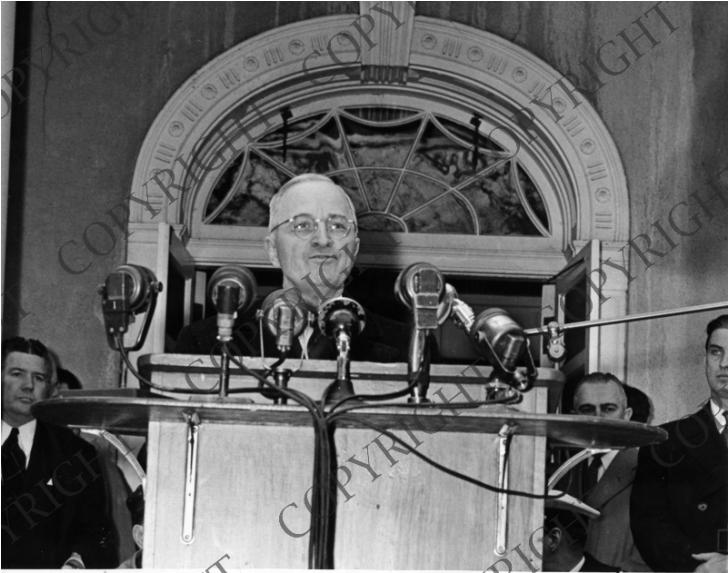


President Truman speaking at dedication of Franklin D. Roosevelt estate
