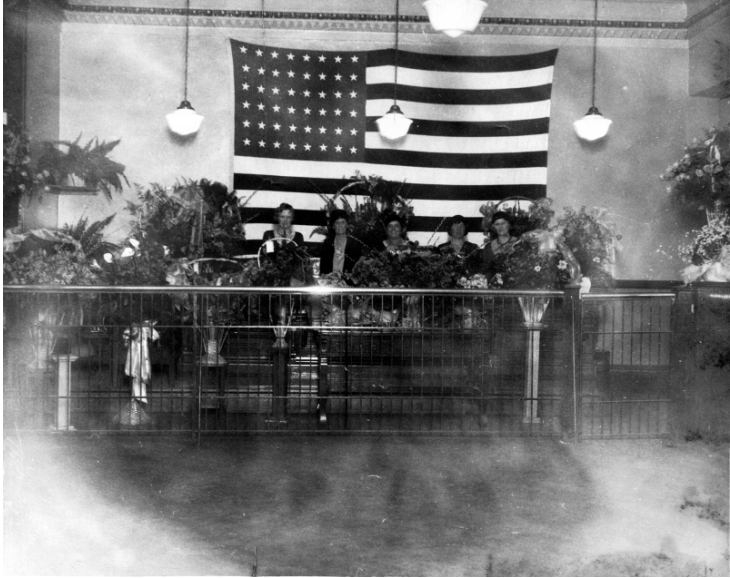


Women attending swearing-in of Jackson County judges
