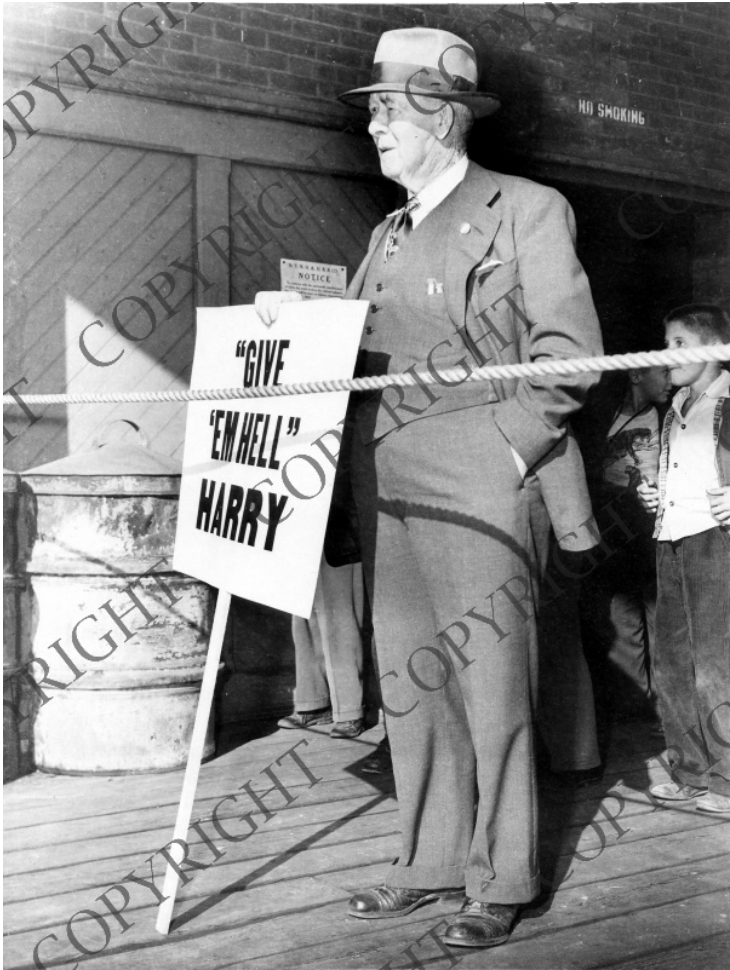


# Man holding "Give 'Em Hell Harry" sign in Connecticut
