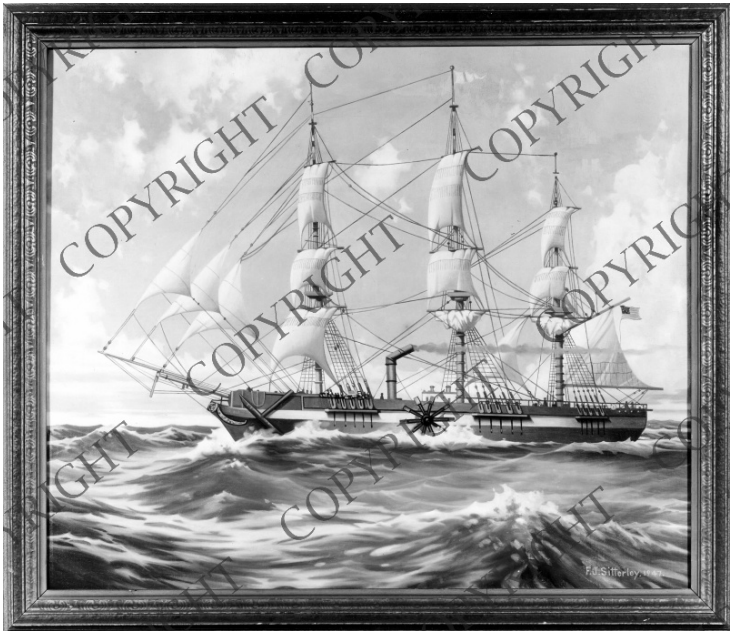


Copy of oil painting of S.S. Savannah
