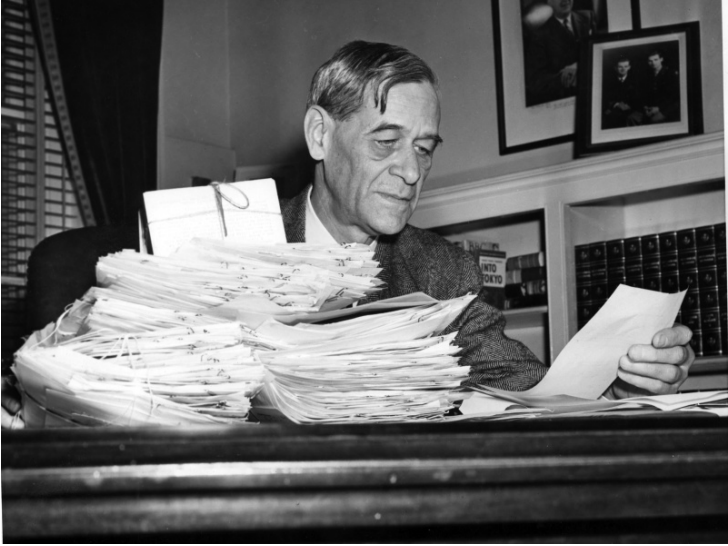


# White House Press Secretary Charles Ross reading letters
