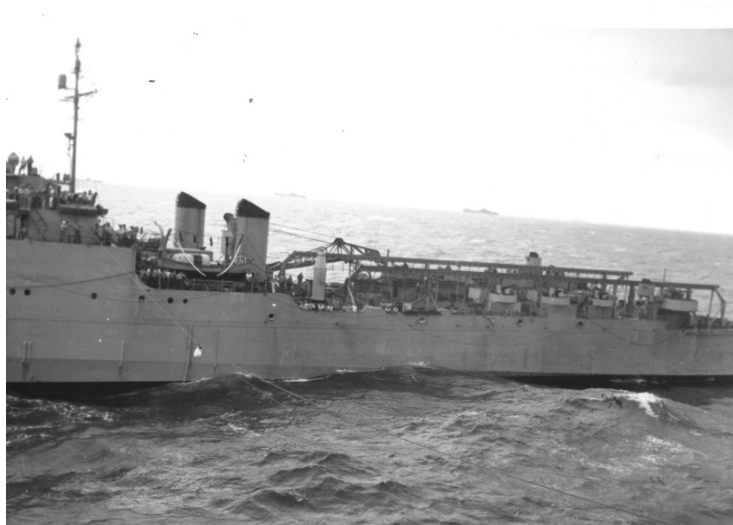


# The ship "Gunston Hall" during Korean War
