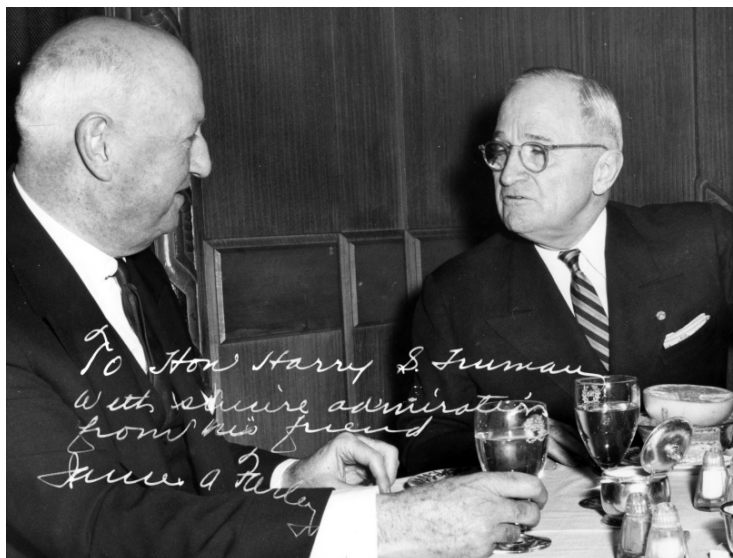


Former President Harry S. Truman and Former Postmaster General James A. Farley
