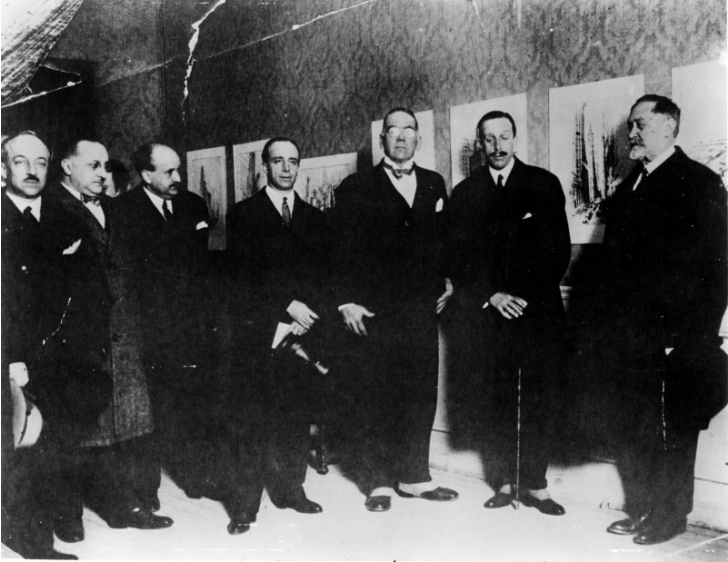


# Alfonso XIII at Opening
