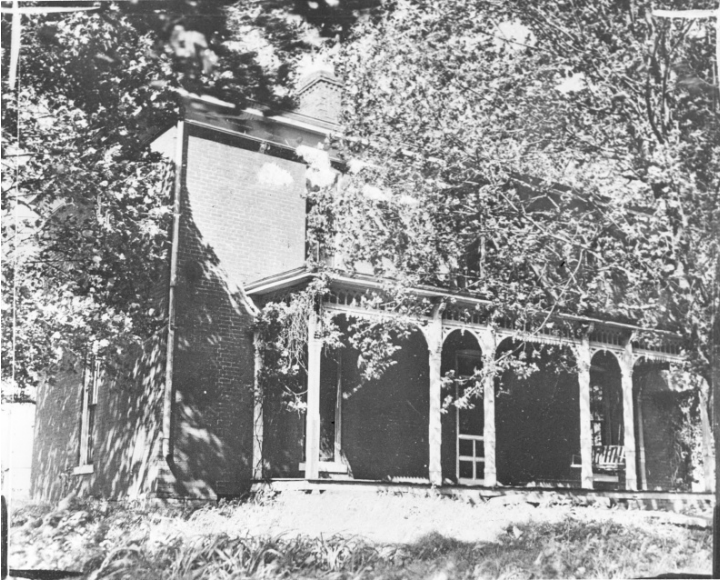


Anderson Shipp Truman's house
