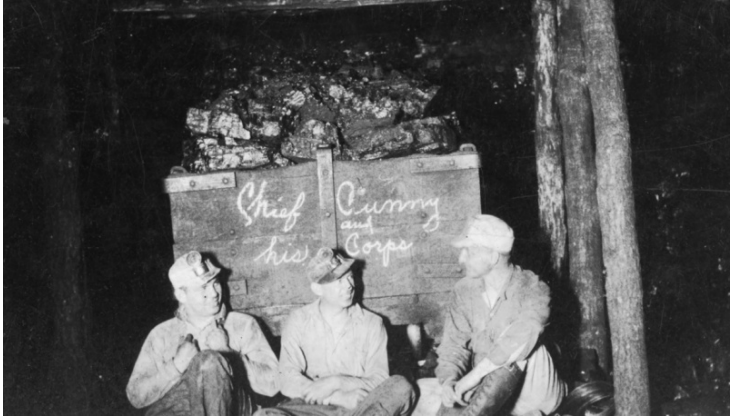

## Description
