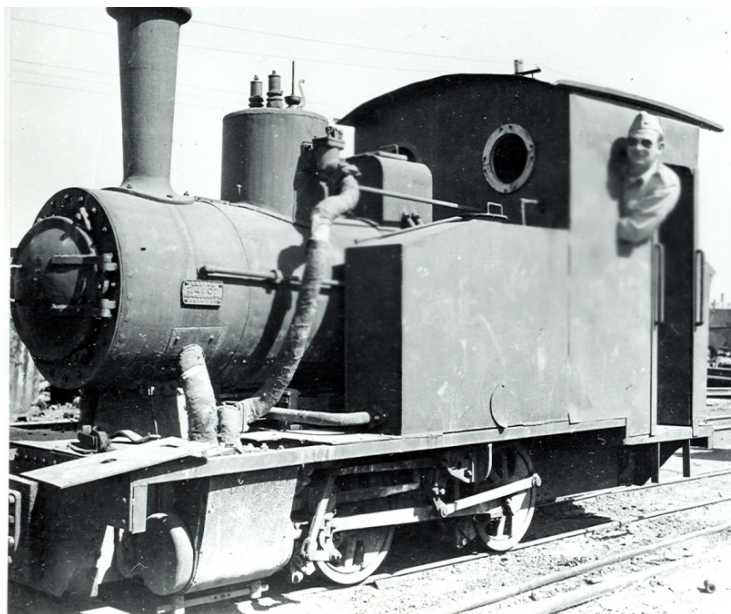


Norman M. Taylor in a train engine car
