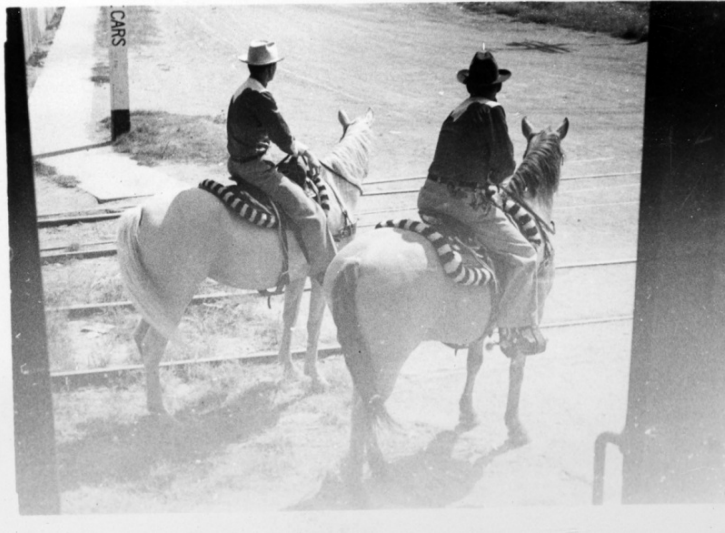


Snapshot of two cowboys taken in New Mexico from President Harry S. Truman's campaign train
