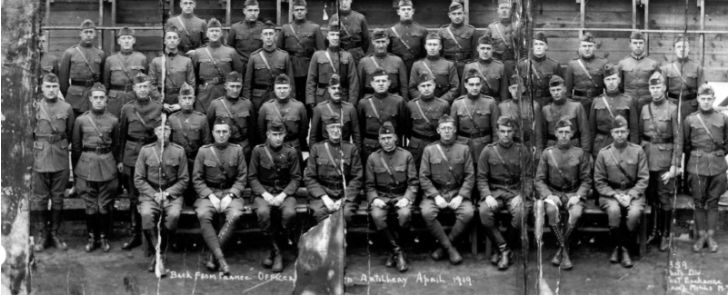


# Officers of the 129th Field Artillery, including Harry S. Truman
