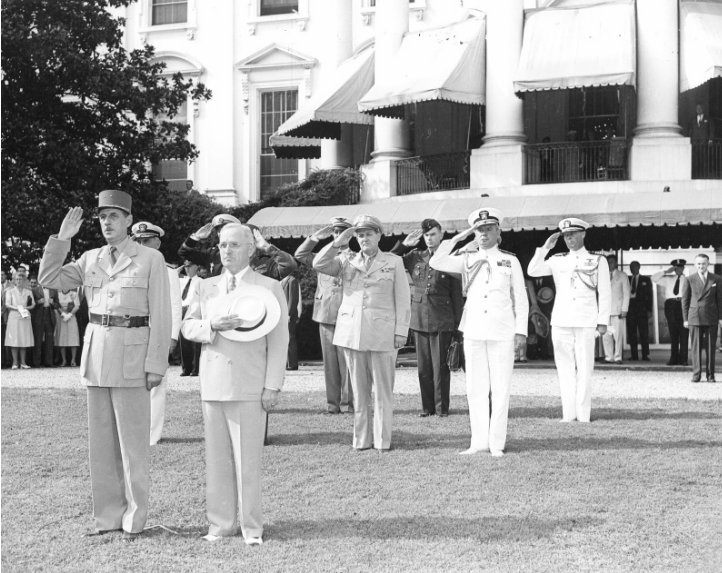


Truman and DeGaulle attend welcoming ceremonies for French visit
