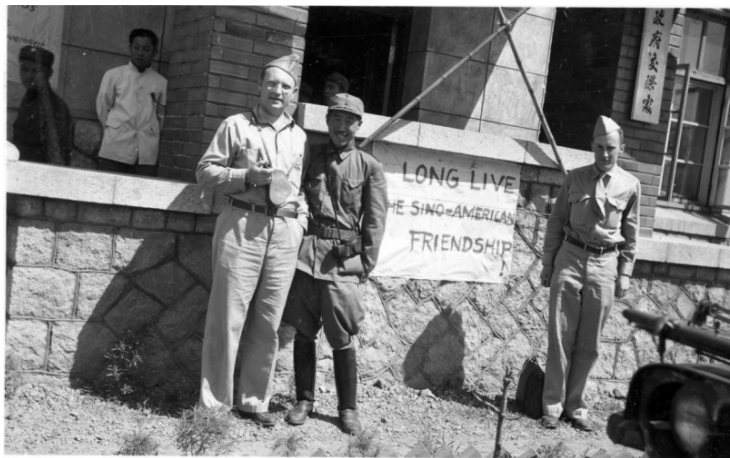


Pauley Party at Hotel in Mutanchiang
