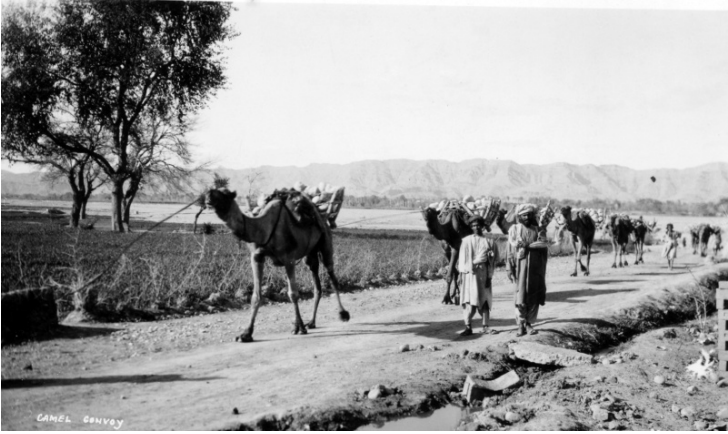


Afghanistan Caravan Moving Along Road
