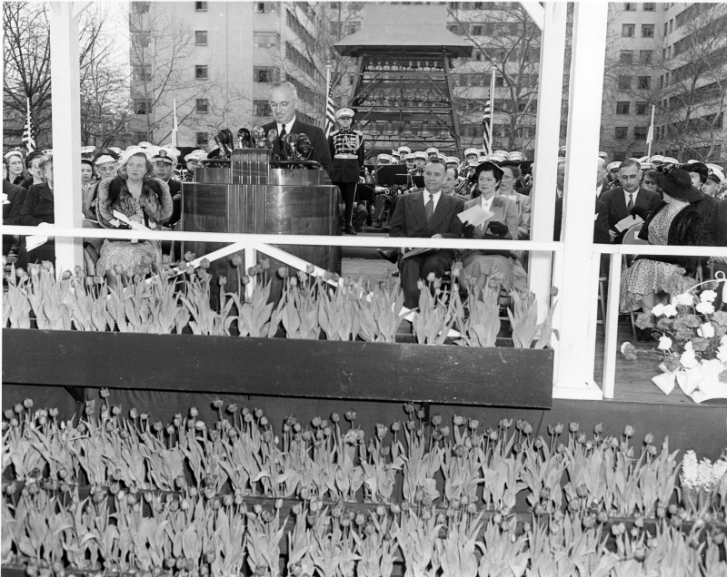


# President Truman Gives Address at Carillon Ceremony
