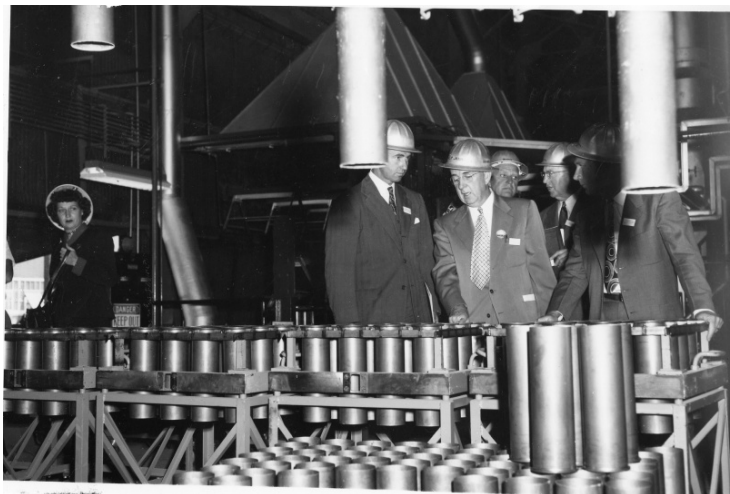


Pace Visits Riverbank Ordnance Plant
