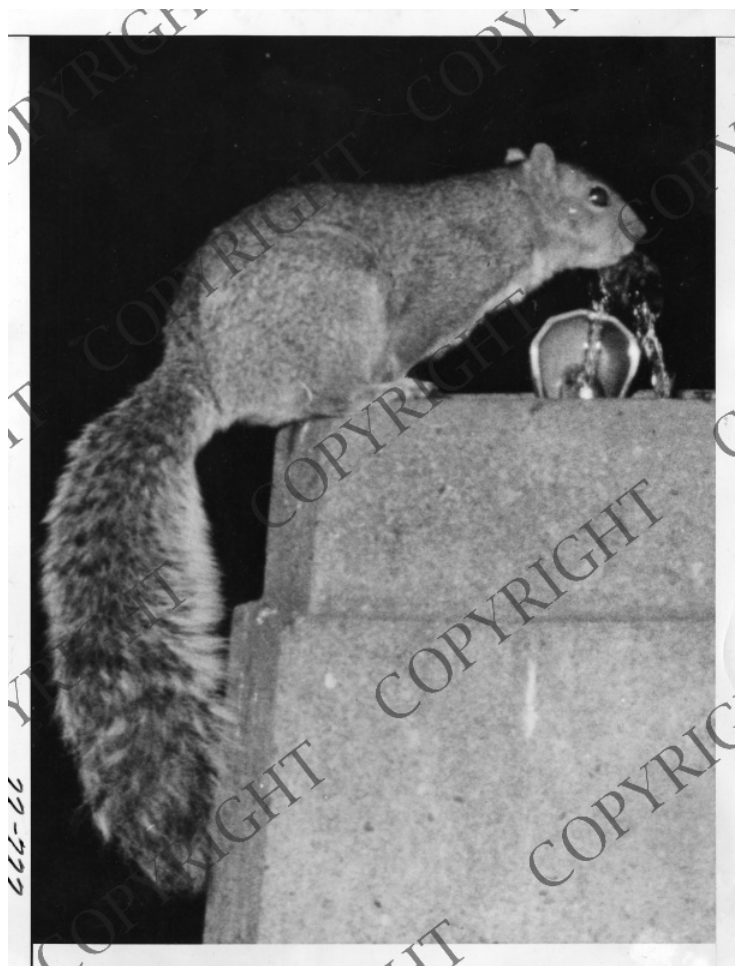


Pete the Squirrel
