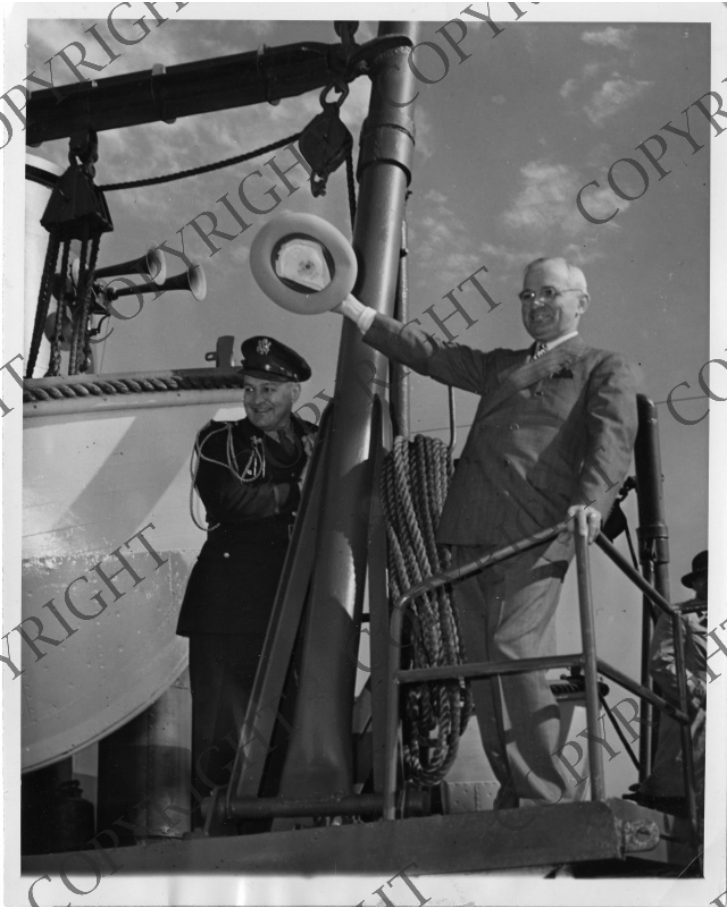


President Harry S. Truman Leaves for Island Picnic
