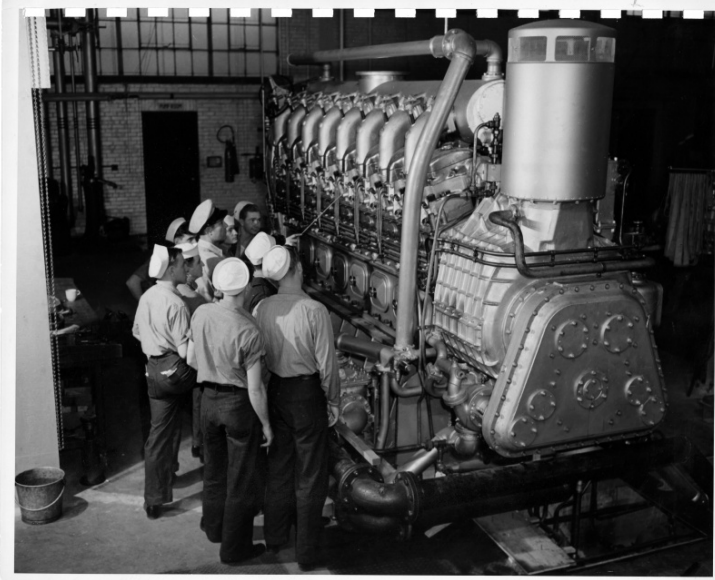


Sailors Receiving Instructions from an Officer at the Submarine School
