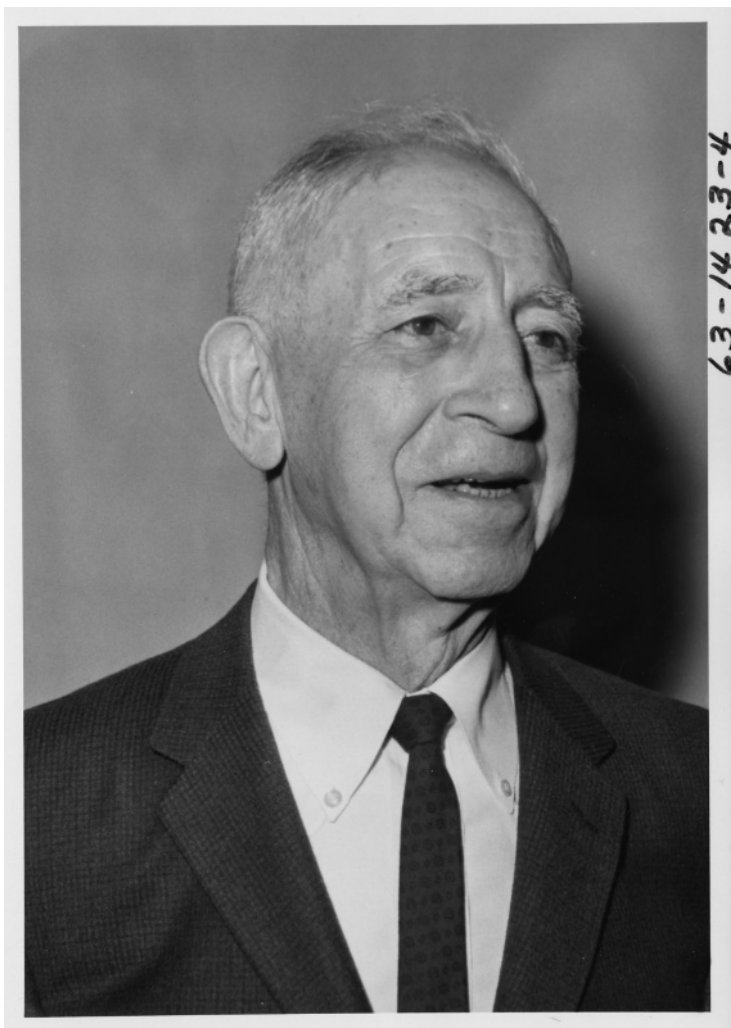


Portrait of Theodore Marks
