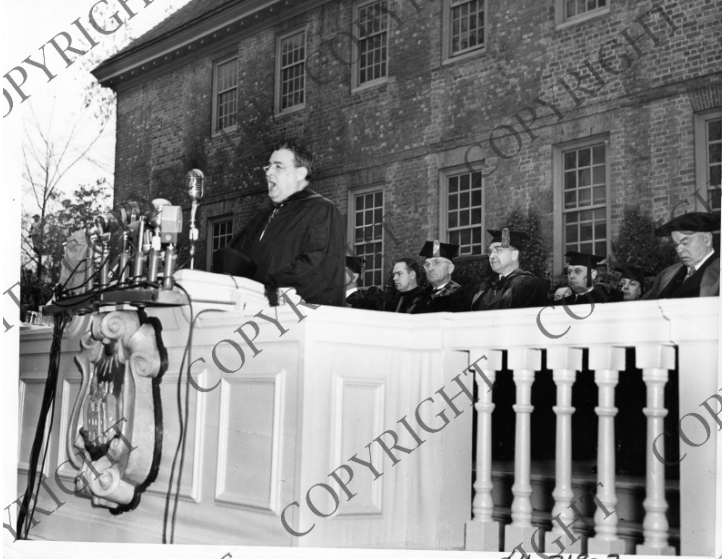


Governor William Tuck Speaks at College of William and Mary Ceremony
