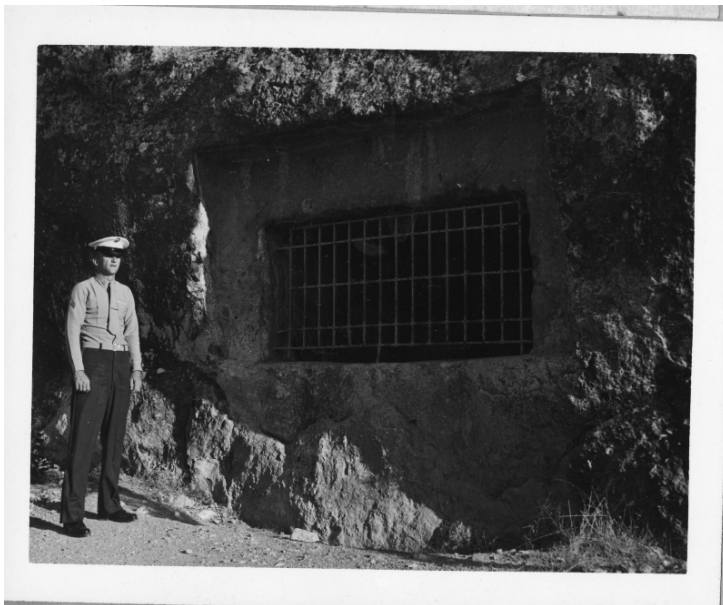


Prison of Socrates
