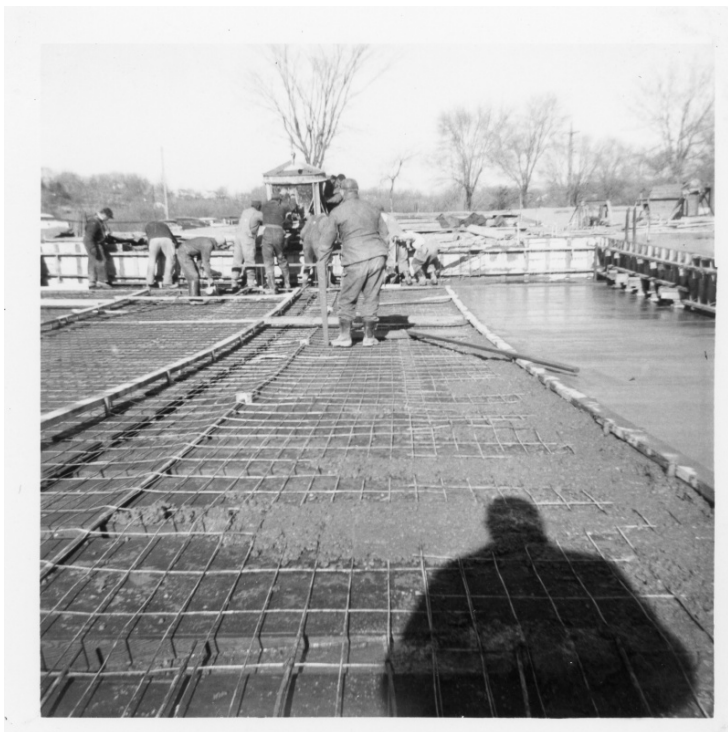


Pouring Concrete for the Floor of the Harry S. Truman Library and Museum
