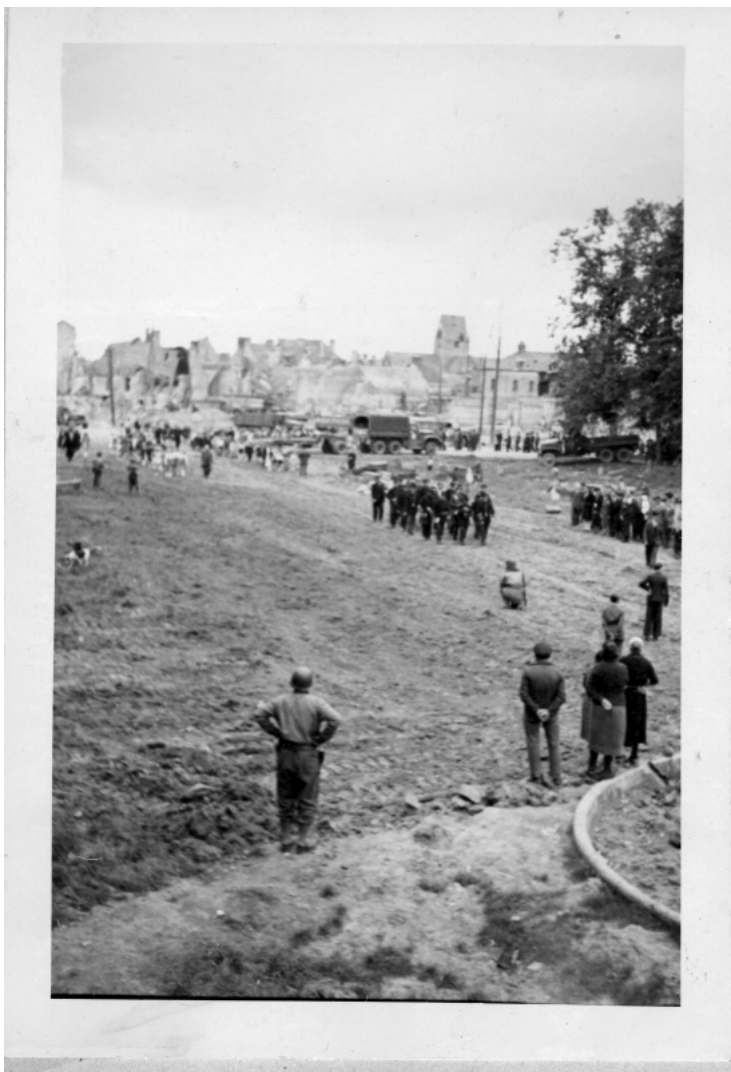


# Bastille Day in Isigny, France
