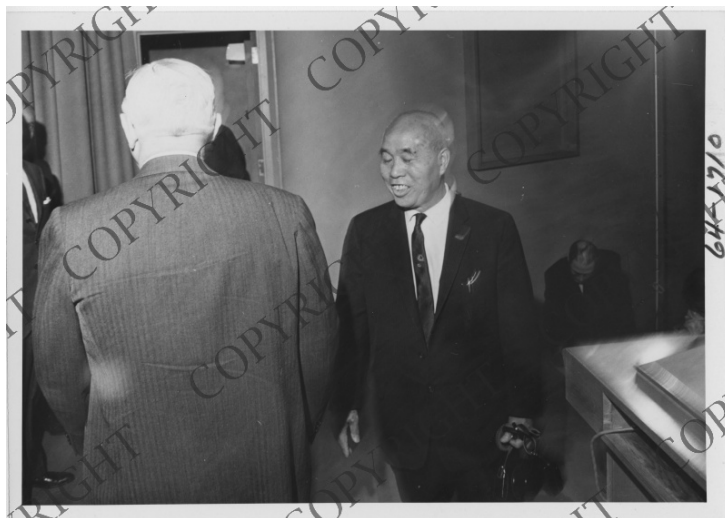


# Former President Harry S. Truman and Man
