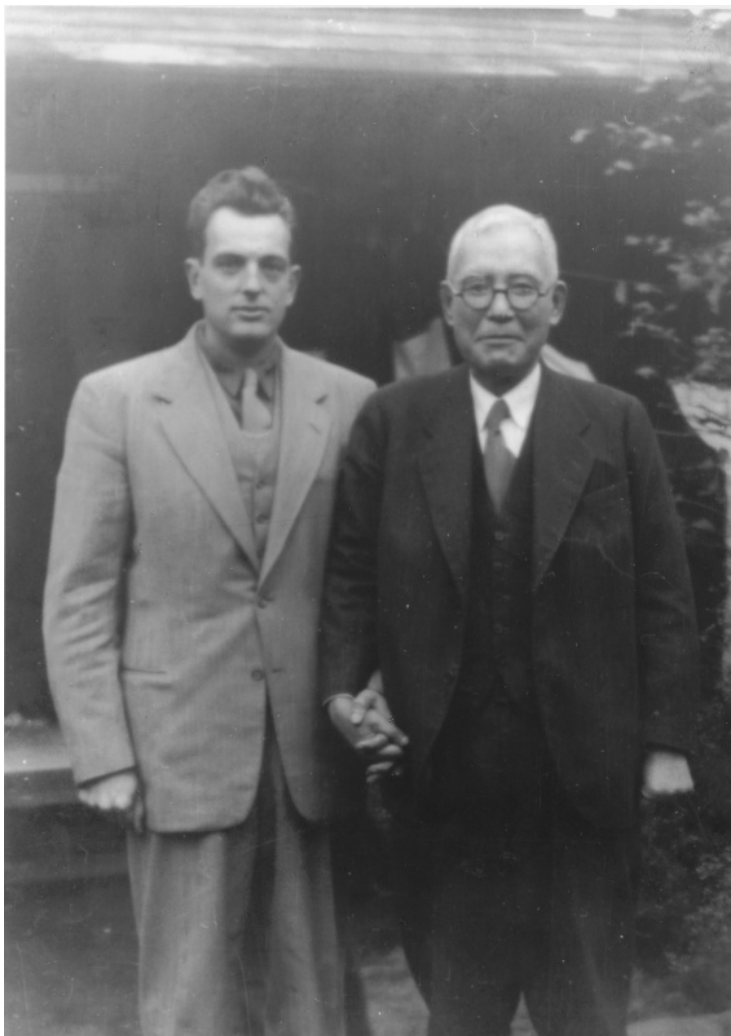


John Brannon and Unknown Man
