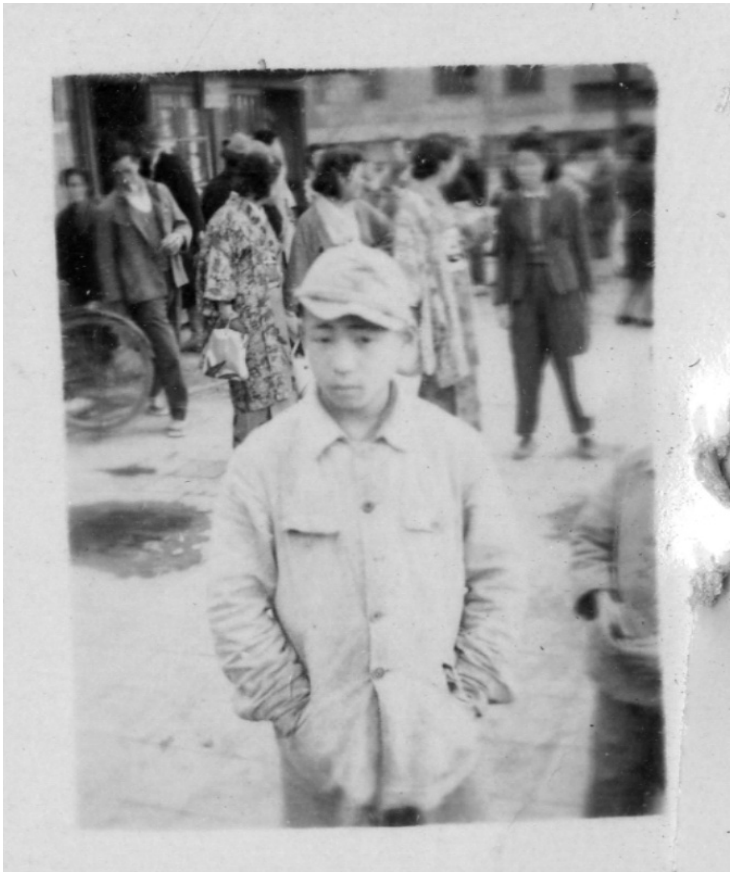


Japanese Boy in Post War Japan
