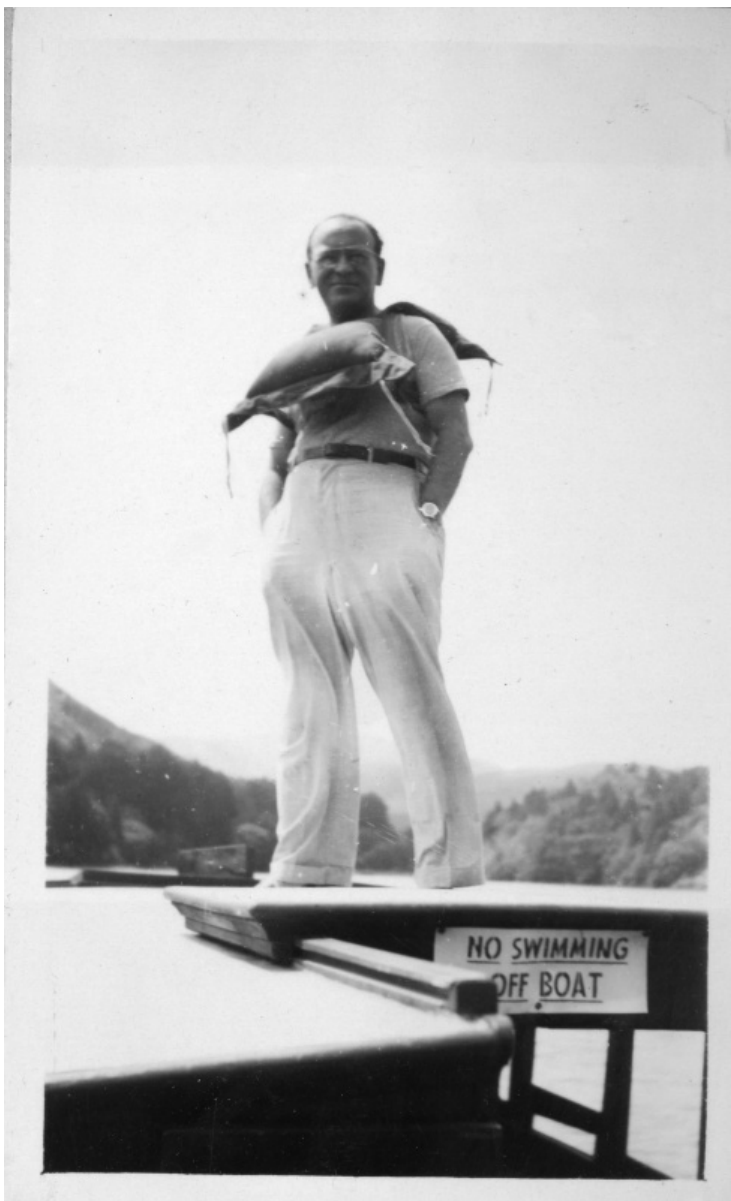


Unknown Man Wearing a Lifejacket
