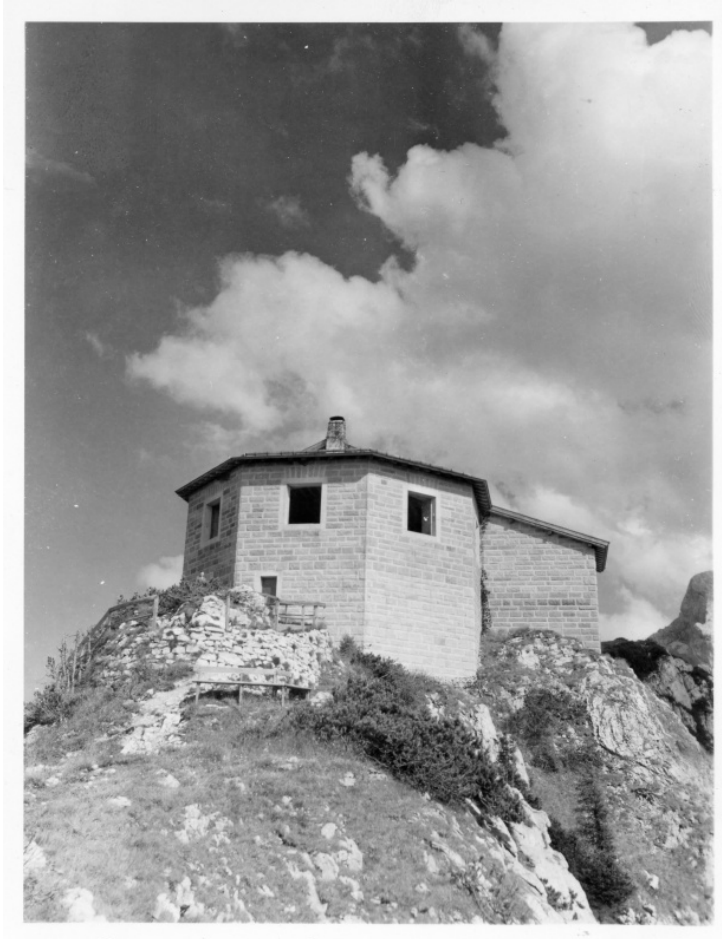


The Eagle's Nest, Berchtesgaden, Germany
