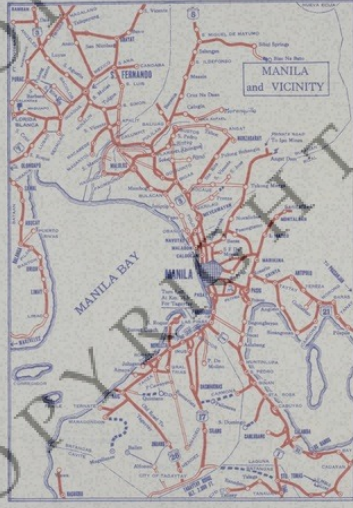


SOCONY ROAD MAP OF THE PHILIPPINES 1940

PLEDGE OF THE ROAD SPORTSMAN

1. Always observe traffic rules.
2. Operate at a speed in keeping with safety conditions.
3. Keep left and, at the proper time signal my intention to stop or turn in either direction. Get in proper traffic lane before turning.
4. Heed "SLOW" and "STOP" Signs and traffic signals.
5. Slow down at intersections and crowded places or when approaching pedestrians.
6. Look out, especially at night, for carabao and other obstructions on highways.
7. Dim lights when approaching another car at night.
8. Never pass another car going in the same direction on a hill, curve or intersection.
9. Not park my car where it will obstruct or endanger other traffic.
10. Not drive when not in condition to do so.
