The map of the Pacific theater shows railroads, rivers, relief, and points of American activity in Iwo, Taiwan, Kobe, Japan, and Manila, Philippines. The map of the Philippines, focusing on Luzon, shows roads, rivers, mountains, raised relief, airfields, and points of American activity moving towards Manila from January 9 to February 4, 1945. The inset, focusing on Manila, shows railroads, roads, rivers, airfields, and other details. Printed text reveals news on multiple fronts. Printed text and photographs on the back describe life in Japan in 1939. This section, titled "Inside Japan," states that "the pictures were taken by an American tourist and are believed to be among the last to leave the country."
