



4. ANSWER the following questions.

\*What nations remained neutral during World War I?

*Spain, Switzerland, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Luxembourg*

\*Which alliance had more members?

*Allied Powers*

\*How was the concentration of Central Powers in the center of Europe both an advantage and a disadvantage?

*Answers will vary but should be logical.*

*For example:*

*Advantage - central location made getting supplies and movement of troops easier and quicker*

*Disadvantage - with the exception of the Ottoman Empire, the Central Powers had to fight a two front war*

## FUN FACTS



Stubby was a real dog whose special coat and medals are preserved by the Smithsonian Institution and are currently on display at the National Museum of American History, Washington D.C.



Stubby managed to get all the way to France with the doughboys of the 102nd Infantry Regiment and served right alongside them, spending over 200 days on the front lines!



Stubby wasn't just a pet; he was a division mascot who became a guard dog and expert rat chaser.



Stubby was able to smell gas before his human counterparts and would raise the alarm for imminent attacks.



Stubby would run on to the battlefield to find wounded soldiers and bark to alert the medics of their whereabouts.

When an enemy soldier snuck in to the allied trenches, Stubby confronted him and bit him on the behind!



Stubby fought in 17 battles and won many medals. He had a special coat made to pin all his awards, a gift from the women of the Chateau-Thierry for helping to save their town.



After the war, Stubby and Robert Conroy toured the country to raise funds and awareness for their fellow veterans.

Stubby truly was man's best friend!

3. Turn over and fold in corners to centre.




4. Turn over and again fold corners in to centre.
