Education Program Assistant [Paid internship]

Interns will help provide an interactive learning experience to elementary age students through an educational program through the Harry S. Truman Library and Museum in Independence, Mo. This paid intern opportunity is available January – April 2023. The interns will work with other interns and volunteers and lead groups of students (8-11 yrs. old) and move students to stations in the museum exhibits and work with students to complete tasks in those areas.

Interns will need to keep the students on track and focused. Interns will also have to keep track of time as students will be accomplishing multiple tasks in various locations.
