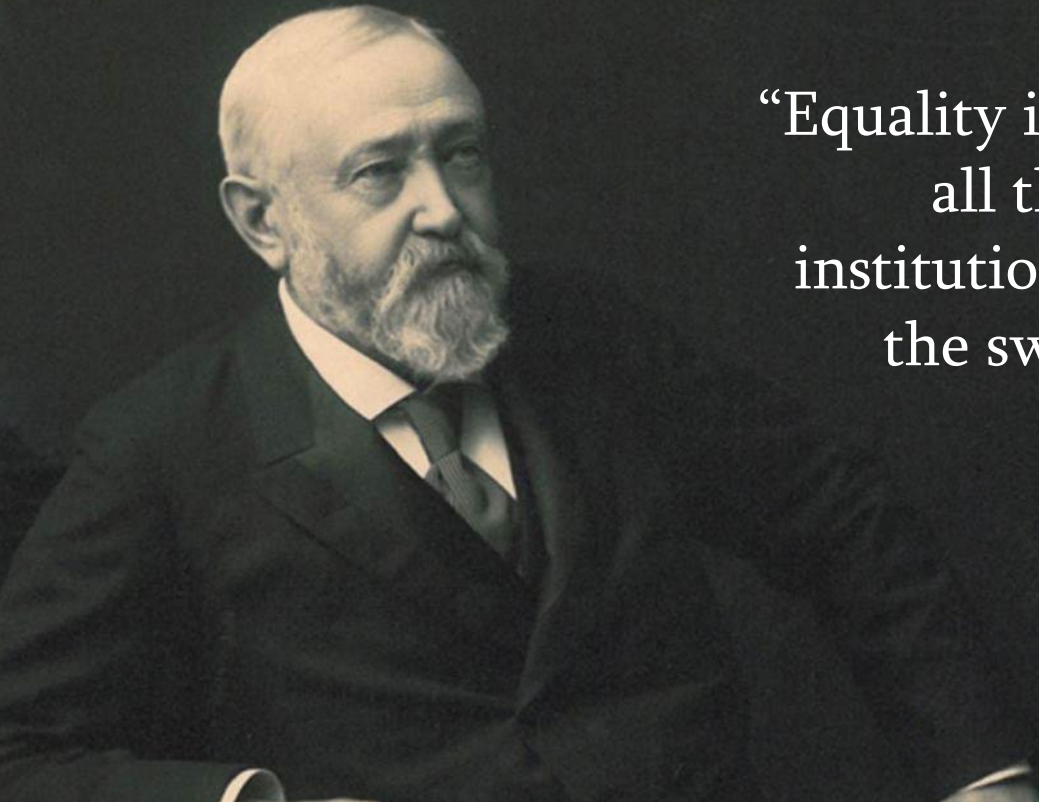


- Mission:** Increase public participation in the American system of self-government by sharing the life stories, arts, and culture of an American President.

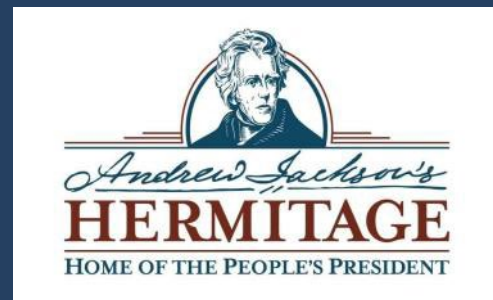
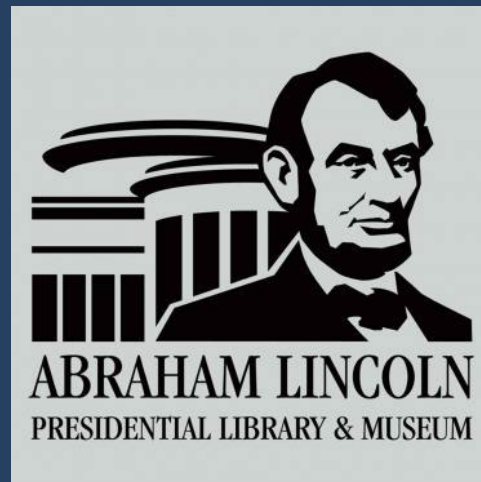
# THINKING FORWARD

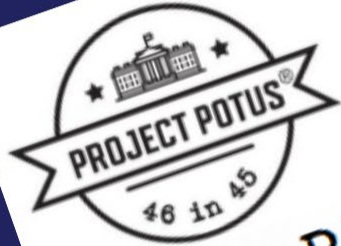

Provide the 'basics' about the president portrayed, including historical context.

#### 2. HISTORICAL CONTENT

Historical content must come from factual, reliable sources. Include and cite at least one primary source or using a citation format.

Provide evidence of effort to share content

#### 3. IMPERSONATION

Impersonation of a president, original or recreated.

"A president can only be elected twice."

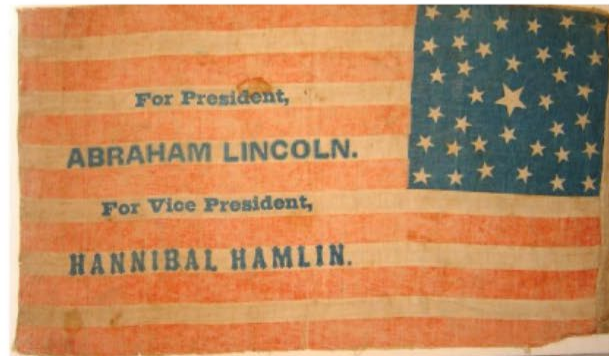




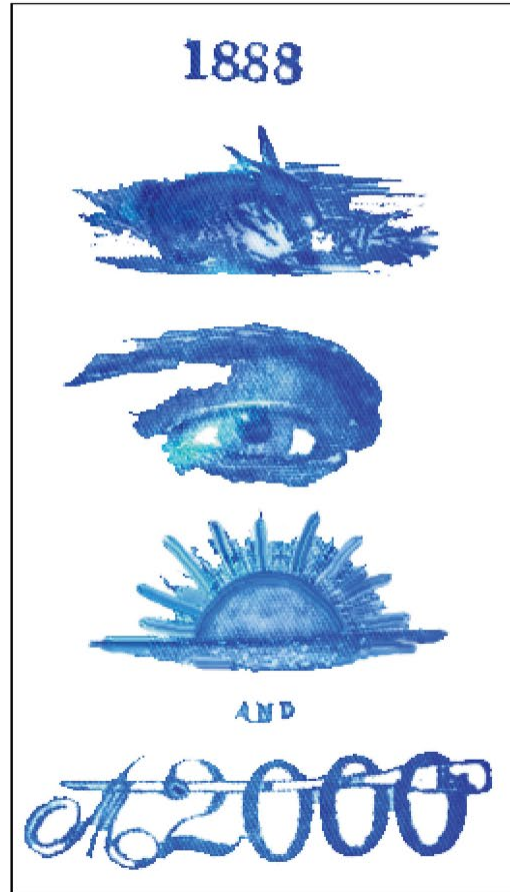

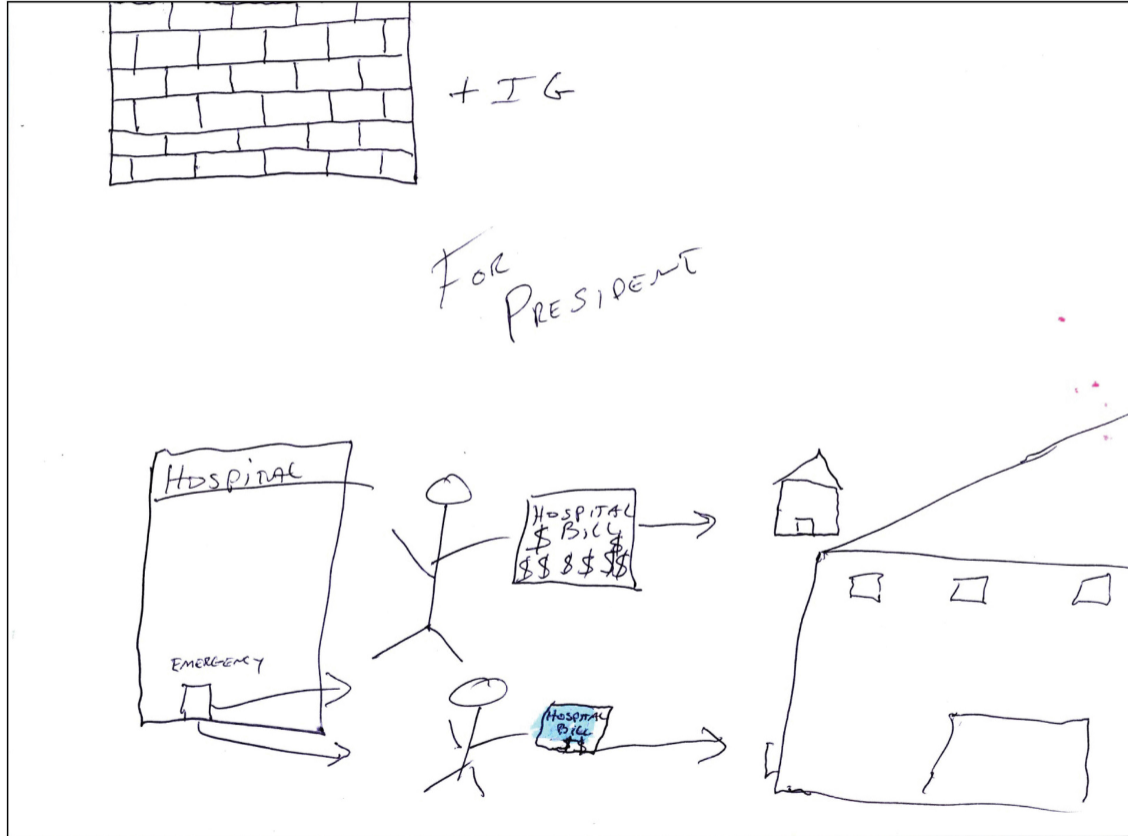
